With the original house dating back to 1904, Beaumont Hall is an elegant conference venue situated in 16 acres of stunning gardens which today form the basis of the University's botanic garden.

Beaumont Hall is ideal as a self-contained venue for groups of up to 80 delegates or can be successfully combined with adjacent conference and residential facilities for larger numbers.

En suite and standard accommodation close to the main house enjoy an appealing courtyard style setting. Of the 98 en suite bedrooms, 12 have been specially adapted for wheelchair users.

Free fixed internet access is available in all bedrooms with free wireless access in most meeting rooms.

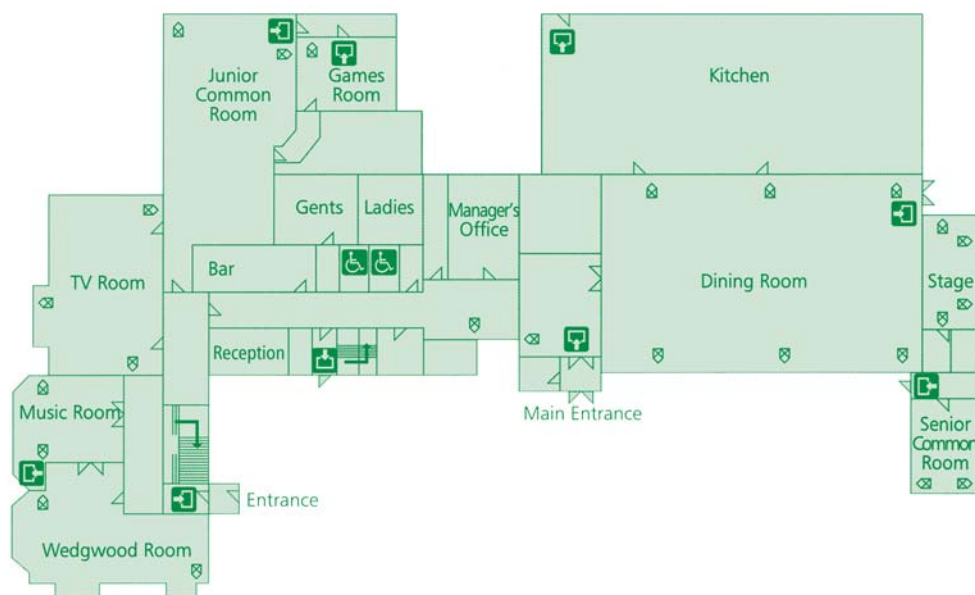

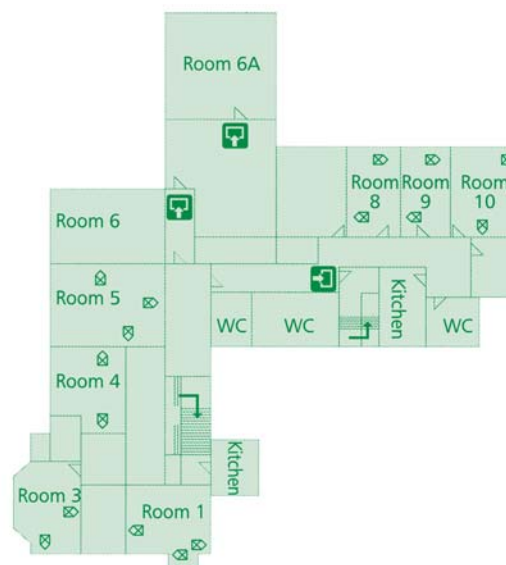
