

**Workshop title:**

Leicester: out and about

**Summary Description:** A series of one-day practical workshops to help you understand your digital camera and develop your photography skills. Go out and take photographs in the city environment and then evaluate the images back in the classroom using a digital projector.

**Detailed Description:** After a short presentation and briefing at the college the learners will walk to local areas of interest. Here they will use their camera to capture an image in a personal response to the scene. Tutor support will help in the setting of the camera controls, assessing the relevance of lighting and vision of view. Learners will have the opportunity of developing compositional skills. They will return to the college to display their image using a digital projector and for group discussion. Selected images can be transferred to their memory stick.

**Objectives/Outcomes:**

- An ability to set camera controls depending upon ambient lighting
- Gain confidence in using their camera in city environment
- Made aware of elements of composition and use of shadows
- The importance of exploring viewpoints and exposure control.
