Summary Description: For players, who want to extend their repertoire, improve their playing skills and study more challenging ensemble pieces. Suitable for those with 5+ years' experience.

Detailed Description: The main aim of this group is to prepare a show case of guitar music at Embrace Arts.

To build a repertoire of ensemble pieces. Learners from the 'Classical guitar for beginners' and the 'classical guitar for intermediate players' will also be invited to join in the show case ensemble.

Learners will review previous work; discuss performance techniques; provide a platform for individual performance; study technical development to greater depth with weekly technical exercises.

Also to guide learners to suitable music they may wish to play that is appropriate to their level of playing.

Advice on the purchase of a better quality guitar and on guitar maintenance; how to change strings; performance skills; how to shape nails and tone production.

Please note:

Learners must provide their own nylon strung classical guitar, footstool and music.

Steel strung guitars are NOT suitable.

Objectives/Outcomes:

Improved their playing skills, extended their repertoire, deepened their appreciation of instrumental playing and enjoyed new ensemble pieces in a friendly group setting.
