Develop your camera skills

Summary Description: A series of one-day practical workshops to help you understand your digital camera and develop your photography skills. Learn how to photograph various arrangements and displays using appropriate camera controls to achieve sharp images with correct exposure.

Detailed Description: A one-day workshop where learners will learn how to use their own camera more effectively through practical activities. These will be supported by group demonstrations and discussions, one-to-one tutoring. A number of table-top displays will be arranged for photographing.

The course will look at the relevance of resolution, its importance on the final image and how to change it when required. Also covered is how to set exposure for various environments and the use of exposure compensation.

Learners will have the opportunity of developing compositional skills and the use of macro mode. Images taken by learners during the day be displayed by using a digital projector for group discussion. These images can be transferred to a memory stick if required.

Objectives/Outcomes: How to set main controls for optimum results for a variety of environment

Ability to choose appropriate shooting mode

Confidence in using close up (macro mode)

Develop composition skills
