Portraiture: speed drawing

Summary Description: You've heard of speed dating – now try speed drawing. A twist on the traditional event where you get to take home lots of scribbly portraits of you done by strangers instead of phone numbers.

Detailed Description: Speed drawing follows the basic principles of speed dating only rather than having 3 minutes to ask and answer questions with your partner you get 3 minutes to draw your partner. Participants on one side all move right to the next person until everyone has drawn everyone. At the end of each 3 minute drawing time you get the big reveal, then drawings are hung up until the end of the event. At the end of the workshop you will have a stack of portraits of yourself to take home. Speed drawing is a fun way to loosen up your drawing practice and give you the opportunity to study from live models, but most of all it produces some hilarious results!

Objectives/Outcomes: Learners will have a stash of portraits of themselves to take home and will have developed confidence in their drawing skills and most of all have fun.
