AIMS AND SCOPE

The International Symposium on Spatial Accuracy Assessment in Natural Resources and Environmental Sciences is held every two years and is concerned with all aspects of spatial accuracy in natural resources and environmental sciences. Following on from successful meetings held in Lisbon (2006) and Shanghai (2008), the ninth symposium returns to Europe and comes to the UK for the first time, to be held at the University of Leicester in the heart of England. Confirmed keynote speakers include Curtis Woodcock, Pierre Goovaerts and Ola Ahlqvist.

All topics concerned with spatial accuracy and uncertainty in a natural resources and environmental sciences context are appropriate, for example:

Semantic uncertainty and vagueness
Modelling uncertainty using geostatistics
Propagation of uncertainty in GIS
Visualizing spatial uncertainty
Uncertainty in Remote Sensing
Spatio-temporal uncertainty
Accuracy and uncertainty of DEMs
Modelling scale in environmental systems
Positional uncertainty

SUBMISSIONS

We welcome the submission of both oral papers and posters. For both modes of presentation authors are invited to submit abstracts of no

more than 500 words in English on original research for international peer review. Those accepted will be presented as oral papers/posters at the symposium and published as short papers in the symposium proceedings (ISBN listed).

All accepted authors will also be invited to submit a full paper for consideration towards an edited book planned as part of Springer's Lecture Notes in Geoinformation and Cartography series and possibly an international journal. Papers submitted for publication in both the symposium proceedings and book/journal should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.

All submissions will be online and at least one author will be required to register/attend the symposium. Details for the submission and guidelines for the format of papers and posters can be found on the conference website.
