Midland History PRIZE

The MIDLAND HISTORY PRIZE, worth £200, is offered in 2009 for the best essay submitted on an historical subject relating to midland England. Candidates must not, at the date of submission, have a published book or an article in a major journal. The essay must be a genuine work of original research, not hitherto published or accepted for publication, and must reach the required standard. The text should not exceed 8,000 words. Candidates must consult the style sheet of Midland History, available from the Editor and must submit their choice of subject to the Editor for approval before sending their essay. Essays must reach the Editor of Midland History by 31st October 2009. The winning essay, and others judged meritorious, will be published in Midland History.
