

# **Triple Science Support Programme**

The Triple Science Support Programme (TSSP) has been developed to support schools that are facing barriers to introducing triple science or extending triple science to a wider cohort beyond their most able students.

## The programme consists of:

- support from an adviser
- a comprehensive package of continuing professional development (CPD)
- access to online communities and resources
- peer to peer support
- networks
- case studies

CPD is a vital part of the support offered to schools. This is free to supported schools and includes:

- New triple science courses
- Other courses relevant to triple science run by the Science Learning Centre East Midlands

A customised action plan will be developed by each school, its adviser and Science Learning Centre East Midlands identifying the most appropriate mix of support from different aspects of the programme. # **Triple Science Biology or Chemistry or Physics**

- Biology (EMC11488): Monday 18 June 2012, 10am-4pm, University of Leicester
- Chemistry (EMC11487): Friday 29 June 2012, 10am-4pm, University of Leicester
- Physics (EMC11486): Thursday 12 July 2012, 10am-4pm, University of Leicester

These one day sessions are intended for teachers that have experience of teaching the specific subject area at Key Stage 4 and would benefit from support in effective teaching and learning of the triple science extension modules. A range of modules from across the awarding bodies will be considered, and teachers should be familiar with the content of their extension modules before taking part in the course.

# Participants will be able to:

- identify some barriers to learning and be better equipped to support student learning
- explore and evaluate different pedagogical approaches in a selection of extension modules
- consider the effective use of practical work and/or technology in supporting teaching

## **Technicians Supporting Triple Science**

(EMC11076): Wednesday 27 June 2012, 10am-4pm, University of Leicester

This one day session is designed for technicians who provide support for practical work in triple science. Participants will be given a hands-on experience of effective and engaging practical ideas and approaches for biology, chemistry and physics. The course will also include where to find resource materials and how to prepare them, and the science and learning points behind the practicals.

- explain a range of effective practical work for triple science
- describe where to resource equipment
- work towards enhancing the practical work used in triple science
