





How to get there:

- At the Riseholme roundabout on the A46 (a) take the A15 direction North.
- After about one mile, turn right following the sign for University of Lincoln -Riseholme Campus (b). Ignore the turning for Lawress Hall.
- Use the **Visitor Carpark.** If it is full, use the overspill car park please park on the verges of the lane, under the trees.
- Ignore the sign Reception on building 4 (as that facility belongs to another organisation) and enter directly either into the main offices at **Riseholme Hall** (building 1, marked out in red on the map) or into the Conference Centre (building 3).

Some tips for your visit:

Visitors must be aware that Riseholme Campus is a facility shared with other
organisations which can have different security protocols and access policies.
You are kindly requested to speak to a member of staff and arrange your visit
in advance.
